## Accelerated Credit and Lending Training

The program provides the participant with an exceptional opportunity for higher level study and professional growth. This Accelerated Credit and Lending Training is designed to assess students on their mastery of the competencies and skills necessary for a successful career in financial services. This program accelerates the leadership and professional development of individuals identified by senior managers as having the potential to assume positions in credit, business and commercial lending with increased responsibilities or mid-level management.

Upon successful completion of the program, learners will receive two College Credit Certificates (CCCs)— one in Banking Operations and the another in Banking Specialist. In addition, the participant will be awarded the American Bankers Association (ABA) Business and Commercial Lending Certificate and Center for Financial Training (CFT) Credit Analysis Certificate. Prerequisite: ACG2001, ACG2011, ACG2011L, ACG2001L or ACG2021, ACG2021L.

### CREDENTIAL STACKABILITY

The Banking Specialist and Operation certificate is a stackable credential in a defined academic pathway. It is part of the AS in Financial Services- Financial Management, which can articulate into the BAS in Supervision and Management.

### CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

At the completion of the program the participants will have a solid foundation leading to endless career opportunities and professional growth in credit policy and administration, credit analysis, business development and commercial lending.

### REGISTRATION

Minimum of 3 years of Banking/Financial Services experience. Enroll in MDC and register for FIN 2990 Operations and Specialist. Upon successful completion of the program, you will be awarded the following college credit courses:
